A few rules of WSC – please read before travelling.

Skiing can be a dangerous activity and there are many unforeseen hazards so anyone using the facilities of WSC does so at their own risk.

Directions: (see website <http://www.skiweardale.com>) From the A689 at Daddry Shield, take the back road on the south side of the river for about 0.5 miles until a small crossroad. Turn right here up the steep hill and carry on for 2.4 miles to the parking. If chains are needed put them on at the lay-by **before** turning up the hill.

The road can be very difficult and at times Winter tyres or Chains may be essential. Weather and road conditions can change quickly so always pack a shovel and carry chains.

Parking: Please park at a 45 degree angle as close as safely to the next car and tight up to the fence. Drive straight in rather than trying to reverse in. **Do Not block any gates under any circumstances.** In the event of deep snow or a full car park you will need to dig yourself in off the road ensuring that you do not obstruct the road.

No dogs or sledges are allowed on the fells.

Please hand this form to the tow operator with the correct money.

Please do not ski until you have paid – attendants wear orange jackets.
