

Weardale Ski Club Covid-19 policy (Updated October 2021)

With the easing of Covid restrictions throughout the UK we are planning to open up for skiing this season as close to normal as possible. We are still advising members to pay attention to the latest government advice and also respect other people and still adhere to a degree of social distancing. Although outdoor exercise is a very low risk for the transmission of Covid-19 you never quite know whether the person next to you is infectious, vaccinated or in a vulnerable group.

You must not attend if you have been told to self isolate or if you are experiencing any Covid symptoms such as fever, continuous cough or change in taste or smell sensation. Even if you have cold or flu-like symptoms we would advise you not to attend unless you have had a negative Covid test in the preceding 48 hours.

Pay attention to social distancing in the lift queue - keep 1 pole minimal distance.

We have re-opened the lodge but reserve the right to close it or limit numbers if it gets too busy. When busy we may introduce a one-way system and may also block off some tables to allow more distancing. Hand sanitisers are provided in the toilets and at both lift stations.

There is a remote possibility that we may limit numbers in exceptional circumstances although the chance of this is very small and we will make an announcement if planned.
